## The Coffee Rebellion



The House Committee has elected to charge \$1.00 for coffee during a meal effective March 1<sup>st</sup>. The lodge will get \$.93 and the state will get about \$.07 in sales tax. You will get a coffee cup, and refills are free, during the meal. We are also looking at getting a Keurig single serving coffee maker for coffee drinks, or just plain coffee, behind the bar in the social quarters. Refills will not be free there. Some members are going crazy over this change. These members have driven officers out of the lodge due to their complaints. They think that it is not fair, and we are being cheap. How could the lodge do this to them?

Coffee has been free to members, but the coffee has not been free to the lodge. Our Farmer's Brothers Coffee bill last year was \$4,637 and we will spend over \$3,000 this fiscal year. Most of that bill is coffee and tea. Some members don't drink coffee, but they have been paying for your free coffee as a member of our lodge, because we all bear the cost. Is that fair? 




